As you know, Bishop Cote has authorized a voluntary Special Collection for the victims of the devastating earthquake that struck Chile on February 27, 2010. The earthquake has claimed hundreds of lives and destroyed countless homes, churches, schools and other buildings and has left millions without the most basic necessities of life.

Winter is beginning in the Southern hemisphere, so the Chilean people affected by the earthquakes will need warm clothing and blankets. The small children and elderly especially require shoes, socks, sweaters and coats for the cold wet winter. Homes now missing walls and roofs need repairs to become habitable once more. In those cases where families have been lucky enough to get one of the government issued plywood sheds to use as a shelter, they need to insulate the thin walls and floors against the winter cold. They also need food, diapers, bottles, formula, medication and water.

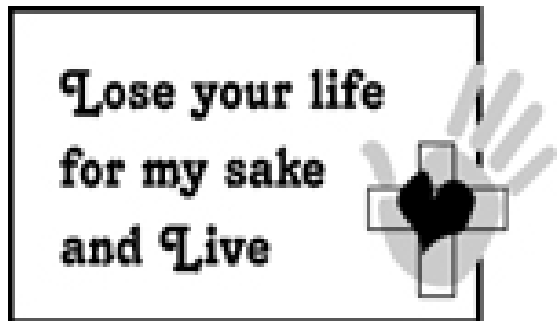
