## SPONSOR INFORMATION FOR CONFIRMATION

The role of a sponsor for the sacrament of confirmation is to "see that the confirmed person acts as a true witness to Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations connected with this sacrament" (Canon 892 from the Code of Canon Law of the Catholic Church).

## A sponsor:

- 1) Must be sixteen years of age or older.
- 2) Must have received the sacrament of confirmation.
- 3) Must be a practicing Catholic and provide testimony from their pastor that they are practicing the faith. This is done through a sponsor certificate.
- 4) Can be of either sex.
- 5) Can be the Candidate's godparent. This is most desirable if possible.
- 6) Can not be the Candidate's parent, but the parent may act as proxy if the sponsor is unable to attend the confirmation liturgy.
